Founder and Chairperson

Neal Bermas, Ph.D., is the founder and chairperson of STREETS International, an innovative social enterprise that provides hospitality and culinary training programs for disadvantaged youth, primarily in Vietnam.

Bermas is an awarded management consultant and educator (New York University, University of Southern California, and the Institute of Culinary Education). Previously he was a consulting services director at PricewaterhouseCoopers and national practice director for Ernst & Young.

He serves on the Board at the Heller School, Brandeis University, and St. Joseph's University, New York. Bermas was recently appointed to the position of Chancellor upon joining the Board of La Chaîne des Rôtisseurs Vietnam. He is a Board Advisor to Destination Mekong Tourism, and an Honorary Judge for the International Social Entrepreneurship in Tourism Competition and the STREETS Global Awards in Hospitality and Tourism.

Dr. Bermas has been quoted and highlighted in publications, including The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, The Financial Times (London), National Geographic, Gourmet Live, AsiaLife, Thanh Nien News, Cong An, Vietnam News (Vietnam), and The Examiner (Australia). In 2018, he was named a CNN Hero of the Year.
